Welcome to the March Edition of the Village Newsletter. The Village Management Office would like to wish everyone a happy and peaceful Easter at the end of the month. 

Village Transport Service

RECYCLING MEDICATION BLISTER PACKS

Late last year, it was raised in the St Agnes' Village Residents Committee, that **plastic blister medication packs** could be recycled at the Rotary Club bin at the Sunrise Rotary and Charles Sturt University markets held on the first Sunday of the month. St Agnes' Village Resident, Lyn Beck, has taken an interest in this and researched further on this wonderful initiative. A receptable is located in the foyer of the Village Management Office to collect plastic medication blister packs for the Sunrise Rotary Club. The plastic can be separated from the aluminium as it is a very pure aluminium. The aluminium is then used to make things such as aluminium windows etc. When the bin is full, the **plastic medication blister packs** will be collected from a Rotary Club representative. To help reduce waste and support this initiative, residents can drop off your used blister packs at the Village Management Office.

Reminder to Residents



A reminder on How to Use the Security Key Locked Box

To Open

- 1. Press down on the clear button on the locked box (black centre button) before beginning.
- 2. Key in the Security PIN code for the locked box.
- 3. Slide and hold the top lever down whilst taking off the removable front section of the locked box.
- 4. Take the front cover with key attached to open the door of your villa.

Please ensure you return your cover in the keybox holder.

To Close/Return cover

- 1. Reposition the removable front cover of the locked box into holder.
- 2. Press down on the clear button on the locked box (black centre button).
- 3. Re-enter the Security PIN code.
- 4. Slide and hold the top lever down and clip into place.

<u>Resident Lock Out procedure</u> – if residents cannot recall the security PIN for their locked key box, the following procedure should be followed:

- During business hours, 8:00am to 4:30pm Monday to Friday, please phone the Village Office on telephone 6584 3515 and a staff member will assist.
- After hours, 4:30pm to 8:00am, Monday to Friday and weekends and public holidays, please
 phone our Nurse Call System Provider, INS LifeGuard who will be able to provide you with the
 PIN number. Please be aware for security purposes, INS LifeGuard will ask you to verify your
 name, villa number and date of birth, prior to providing the PIN.
- If residents are unsure of how to access the locked box using the PIN, you can ask for assistance from your neighbour.



Don't forget to test your INS LifeGuard Personal Alarm System and SmartTracker this month. Also ensure your INS LifeGuard IP Dialler remains on, even when you are away on holiday. Please notify the Village Office or INS LifeGuard if you will be away.



INS LifeGuard SmartTracker hint.

There is a button on the side of the LifeGuard SmartTracker with a telephone symbol on it. This button is able to turn the device on and off. As the button is level with the side of the device, it is easy to turn the device off without knowing.



One of the first indicators is that there is no green and blue flashing lights (flashing means they are connecting to Telstra and the GPS). If the device looks like it is not charging, press the telephone symbol at the side to see if the lights start flashing and it may also vibrate. If this does not happen, or you believe there is an issue with your SmartTracker, please phone the Village Office on 6584 3515 and we will arrange for this to be sent to INS Lifeguard for repair or replacement.

What if I can't hear the SmartTracker or the nurse?

Voice Tone may have been turned off.

The SmartTracker should speak to you during certain tasks — for example, when you've triggered an alarm. If you don't hear the SmartTracker speak to you, or you are unable to hear our nurse, please ensure Voice Tone hasn't been turned off.

The Voice Tone button is the lower button on the left edge of the device. Press it twice and it will advise whether Voice Tone is ON or OFF. Please ensure that it's turned ON.

If that doesn't solve the problem, please contact INS LifeGuard for further assistance on 1800 636 226.



REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

For all **general maintenance requests (including maintenance to common areas)** and **after hours' emergency** maintenance requests, **Village residents MUST** call the hotline on <u>1300 522 511</u> or email the details to <u>maintenance@stagnesparish.org.au</u> (24 hours a day 7 days a week).

It is important that this is adhered to as the jobs will be logged through ISS and then given to maintenance staff. **PLEASE DO NOT RING MAINTENANCE STAFF DIRECTLY ON THEIR MOBILE PHONE.** When calling after hours or on a weekend, please stay on the phone to listen to the procedure. DO NOT HANG UP! If life or structure is in danger, call triple zero (000).

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONS IN VILLAS

Any additions, which includes screen doors, air conditioning units, ceiling fans, patios etc, must be approved by Village Management prior to work being undertaken. Please provide a written request to the Village Manager. A written response will then be provided to you.
